Hazon (Revelation) 19:1 ”

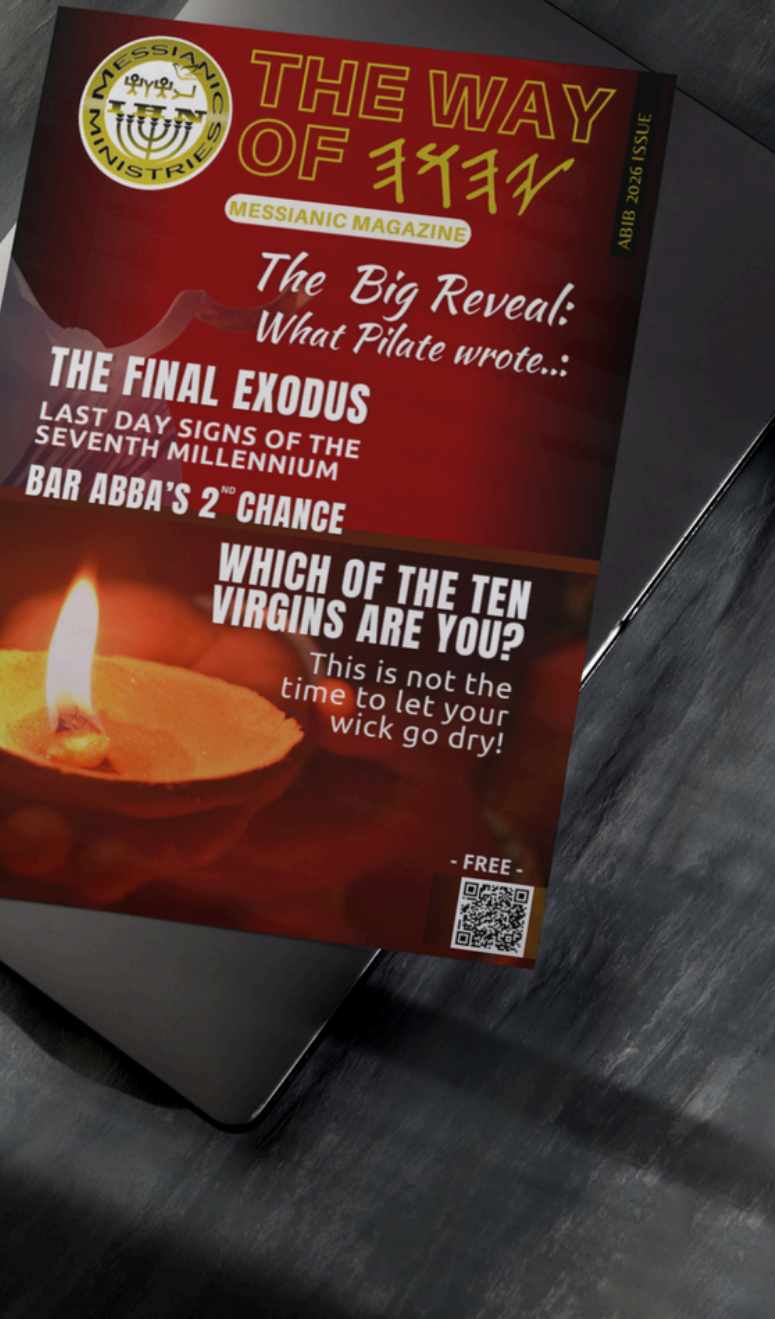

A BIB is the only month in the entire Scriptures that was given a name by the Most High YAH! In like manner, SABBATH was the only day of the week that He called by name.

He does nothing without purpose, and by assigning names to specific times (or appointed times), He sets them apart and uses these times to teach us deeper truths! We can get caught up in the nuances of days, weeks, months, years, and seasons—and completely lose sight of the whole point! Messiah is in it all!

The Month of Abib was first mentioned in Shemoth (Exodus) 13:2, and the Hebrew word for Abib (אֲבִיב) was first mentioned in Exodus 9:31, referring to the state of barley that spring. Abib marked a major turning point in the lives of YAH's chosen people—the seed of Abraham, with whom He had made a covenant, in which many promises were enshrined. One of these assurances given to our forefather, Abraham, was that although his descendants would be in bondage to the Egyptians for 400+ years, He—The Most High YAH—would deliver them and bring them into their inheritance (Genesis 15:13).

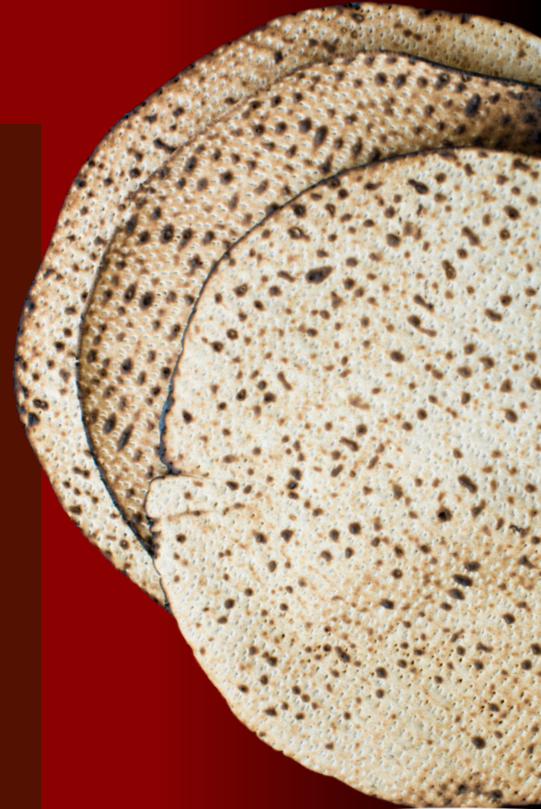
Prophetic promises can have multiple tiers of fulfillment. This one is no different.

Even as YAH brought His people out of Egypt at the end of those 430 years, He is getting ready again to deliver the descendants of Abraham, now scattered across the four winds, across the nations of the globe! Just as He did then, when He finally brings us up—firstly out of Spiritual Egypt/Babylon and secondly out of modern-day Egypt/Babylon—He will also bring up a mixed multitude of the 70 nations of the world, to join as one with the descendants of Abraham.

So although, in a sense, Passover was fulfilled in Messiah  when He died and was sacrificed for us—also in the month of ABIB—Passover will again be fulfilled when He delivers us, by a strong hand and outstretched arms, out of wherever we are in these distant lands. That is our hope!

WILL IT BE HOT CROSS BUNS OR UNLEAVENED BREAD, EASTER HAM OR LAMB?

TIME-HONORED TRADITIONS VERSUS THE CREATOR'S COMMANDS



YAH SAYS IN LEVITICUS 23:4-8:

"These are the appointed times of **אֱלֹהִים**, set-apart gatherings which you are to proclaim at their appointed times. In the first new moon, on the fourteenth day of the new moon, between the evenings, is the Pěsaḥ (or Passover /Pesach) to **אֱלֹהִים**. And on the fifteenth day of this new moon is the Festival of Matzot (or Unleavened Bread) to **אֱלֹהִים** – seven days you eat unleavened bread. On the first day you have a set-apart gathering, you do no servile work. And you shall bring an offering made by fire to **אֱלֹהִים** for seven days. On the seventh day is a set-apart gathering, you do no servile work!!

I used to think hot cross buns were just a special type of Creole buns made by Belizean matriarchs. I did not realize until late in my adult life that this is an almost universal tradition, linked with the global Easter celebration for quite some time. I learned this when I began to gain an understanding of the origins of Easter.

The celebration of Easter around March/April each year demonstrates the belief by Christians in general that the Messiah died in Spring. Ancient civilizations had various times of the year when they marked the New Year, some on December 25, others March 1, and then January 1. With the adoption of the Gregorian calendar in the 16th century, January 1 was established as the civil New Year.

According to [History.com](https://www.history.com), "The earliest recorded festivities in honor of a new year's arrival date back some 4,000 years [2,000 BC] to ancient Babylon. For the Babylonians, the first new moon following the vernal equinox—the day in late March with an equal amount of sunlight and darkness—heralded the start of a new year."

Today's celebration of Easter—which in 2026 falls on Sunday, 5 April—follows a similar timing, the difference being that it is always celebrated on a Sunday ('*deis solis*'—the day of the Sun). The [Encyclopedia Britannica](https://www.britannica.com) says: "The Council of Nicaea in 325 decreed that Easter should be observed on the first Sunday following the first full moon after the spring equinox (March 21). Easter, therefore, can fall on any Sunday between March 22 and April 25."

This is where the wisdom of YAH is needed, as He Himself gives very clear instructions on the appointed times we are to celebrate—including the observance He calls Passover or Pesach—celebrated in truth not with leavened hot cross buns but with unleavened bread. He specifically commands His people to put away leaven—in the physical and spiritual sense—from His dwelling place, which is our bodies.

After the celebration of Passover, we observe 7 days of Unleavened Bread, the first and last of which are annual Sabbaths, when we cease from secular work. This period reminds us of the period when our Messiah was laid in the tomb and resurrected—three days and three nights (or 72 hours) later—at the end of the Sabbath during that Passover week when he was put to death. Likewise, we are to put to death our worldly and sinful ways, so that we could truly live in and with Him!

The international community today marks time by the Gregorian Calendar. This civil calendar, named after Pope Gregory XIII, is the norm for most countries, especially in the Western world. According to the [Encyclopedia Britannica](https://www.britannica.com), "the Gregorian calendar, also called New Style calendar, solar dating system [is] now in general use. It was proclaimed in 1582 by Pope Gregory XIII as a reform of the Julian calendar." There has been a general movement towards calendar reform, and according to international standard (ISO 8601), Monday is now considered the first day of the week, which would make Sunday the seventh day of the week, rather than the Scriptural seventh day—known as the SABBATH.

GENESIS OF THE CHRISTIAN EASTER AND LENT

Where is Easter mentioned in the Scriptures? Acts 12:4 in the King James version is the only place that does, but in error! It says, "And when he had apprehended him [Kepha / Peter], he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after **Easter** to bring him forth to the people."

There is no other mention of Easter in the Scriptures. However, we note that this word "Easter" was translated from the Greek, **pascha** (G3957 - πάσχα) or pas'-khah, which is linked to the Hebrew: **pesach** (H6453 - פסח) or peh'-sakh. The actual translation should have been PASSOVER - not Easter. In the previous article, we looked at the origins of Easter, which was eventually linked to the observance of Lent, on the claim that the 40 days of fasting were linked to the 40 days the Messiah spent fasting in the wilderness. However, the timing is off by 6 months, because the Messiah's fast actually came 40 days before the fall festivals and not the spring festivals.



ROMAN CATHOLIC INSTITUTIONS

The history and chronology of the establishment of Easter and Lent are widely publicized on the web. Here are some key facts from the **Britannica**:

There was a controversy over the timing of the celebration of Messiah's death and resurrection: *The churches opted for the Sunday celebration, and the Quartodecimans ("14th day" proponents) remained a minority.*

*The English word Easter, which parallels the German word Ostern, is of uncertain origin. One view, expounded by the Venerable **Bede** in the 8th century, was that it derived from Eostre, or Eostrae, an Anglo-Saxon goddess possibly associated with spring and fertility.*

According to a **Catholic publication**, "In 461 A.D., Pope St. Leo established the duration as 40 consecutive days before Easter. Pope Gregory the Great, in the sixth century, added the dispensing of ashes the preceding Wednesday (Ash Wednesday), making Lent 46 days. Sundays were considered feast days and not included in the count."

FACTS ABOUT LENT:

- It is celebrated over 40 days.
- It spans 6 consecutive weeks.
- Abstinence is practiced each of the 6 weeks, for a total of 6 Fridays.
- The 6 Sundays right before Easter are excluded from the fast.
- It starts on a Wednesday and runs up to "Holy Thursday."

PASSOVER IN PROPHECY

Symbols of Our Final Deliverance

The children of the Most High are commanded in Uayyiqra (Leviticus) 23:4-8 to keep the appointed times of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ**, starting with the **Feast of Unleavened Bread or Châg Hamatstsot** (אֶת חַג הַמַּצּוֹת). This is a seven-day festival that is observed during the first Scriptural month of Abib, which happens in what we know today as Spring. There is both historical and prophetic significance to this celebration, as there is with every other Scriptural appointed time or celebration.

The feast clearly points to the saving work of our loving Messiah **וְיֵשׁוּעַ**, which He accomplished about 2,000 years ago. He is our Passover Lamb, His body is the true unleavened bread (being sinless) and His blood is the true wine (unfermented grape juice, the 'blood of grapes'). He Himself explained the meaning of the Passover symbols known even before the Exodus.

The Passover season was foreshadowed in the story of our forefather, Abraham, to whom the Father appeared in Berëshith (Genesis) 18, when He came to deliver judgment upon Sodom and Gomorrah. At the same time, He announced the future birth of Yitshaq, which He said would be fulfilled at the set time or 'appointed time' the following year (see verse 14).

In verse 6, we see Abraham commanding Sarah to "Hurry, make ready three measures of fine flour, knead it and make cakes." Sarah was making unleavened bread. This is elaborated later, as unleavened bread was also served by Lot to the messengers who visited him to deliver him and his family before the destruction of the city where they lived.

Moving on to Gen 19:3, we read: "...And he [Lot] made them [the messengers] a feast, and baked unleavened bread, and they ate." As the story unfolds, we see that Lot and some of his relatives were taken out from Sodom and Gomorrah, and the entire place was destroyed, as the Father rained down fire and brimstone upon it!

Fast forward to the days of the Exodus, and we see that **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** Himself, by the hand of Moshe and Aharon, came to deliver His people out of bondage in the midst of the 10 plagues of Egypt.

This pattern will be repeated near the close of earth's history, after the final 7 plagues, as the Father reaches out His hand, through the messengers, to deliver His elect from the four winds, before destroying the kingdom of Satan (Mat 24:31 & Mar 13:27).

This will NOT be a secret rapture, as every eye will see Him and there will be a great sound of a trumpet that will be unmistakable.

Châg Hamatstsot (Feast of Unleavened Bread) is a feast for all generations to observe and nothing, not even the most time-honoured traditions, can ever replace what **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** has ordained as special times to meet with Him!

PASSOVER (חַדְשׁ - Pesach in Hebrew) is an annual Scriptural festival that transcends all generations of human history. The first foreshadowing of Passover came in the book of Berëshith (Genesis) when **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** prophesied: "*And I put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed. He shall crush your head, and you shall crush His heel* (Gen 3:15)."

The prophecy, amazingly, told the end from the beginning, as **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** told Satan, after he instigated the fall of Adam and Chuah (חַוָּה), that his demise was certain. The words "*He will crush your head,*" pronounced a deathblow on the enemy.

Although this deathblow is yet to come, the second part of the prophecy has been fulfilled: "*...you will strike his heel.*"

Approximately two thousand years ago, or 40 yobels, the seed of the woman, **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** Messiah, was nailed (hands and feet) to a torture stake. This happened on Passover Day, which was at the time the middle of the week (not Friday), fulfilling the prophetic word given to Danyal that the Messiah would be cut off in the middle of the week, both in the literal sense and in the prophetic sense.

Messiah was cut off at 3.5 years into His earthly ministry, but the final 3.5 years of the prophetic word comes as the great tribulation unfolds. At the end of that prophetic week, the word of **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** will come to pass. Danyal 9:26-27 sums it up and concludes that the one who lays waste shall himself be laid waste, according to what the Almighty has already decreed!

The True Messiah will return soon, and when He does, Satan will be bound in chains for a thousand years, and the earth will finally have its Millennial Sabbath - a thousand years of tranquility!

THE FINAL EXODUS

LAST DAY SIGNS OF THE SEVENTH MILLENNIUM

But understand this: In the last days terrible times will come. For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, profane, unloving, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, without love of good, traitorous, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of Alahym, having a form of set apartness but denying its power. Turn away from such as these! (2 Timothy 3:1-5)

The Messiah in MattithYahu (Matthew) 24 gave us a series of signs of the end of the age. It is a well-known checklist that is almost nearly being fulfilled in our time. However, there is one significant milestone that we are told to watch for, as the most telling sign of the end: the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION. This is not a term commonly used in ordinary language, so the first challenge is to understand what the "ABONIMATION OF DESOLATION" means. Messiah gives us some context. He says that Danyal the Prophet wrote about it. So first, let us see exactly what Danyal wrote:

Dan 11:31 "...His forces will rise up and desecrate the temple fortress. They will abolish the daily sacrifice and set up the **abomination of desolation.**"

The focus of this article is not on the past instances where the Set Apart Temple of YAH was desecrated. It is on the future, final fulfilment spoken of by Shaul (Paul). He says: "Let no one deceive you in any way, for [the end] will not come until the rebellion occurs and the man of lawlessness—the son of destruction—is revealed. He will oppose and exalt himself above every so-called god or object of worship. So he will seat himself in

the temple of Alahym, proclaiming himself to be Alahym (2 Thessalonians 2:3-4)."

Shaul noted that this "mystery of lawlessness" was already at work. He adds that "the coming of the lawless one will be accompanied by the working of Satan, with every kind of power, sign, and false wonder, and with every wicked deception directed against those who are perishing, because they refused the love of the truth that would have saved them."

This powerful delusion is explained in the Book of Revelation. In Revelation 13, we see that the enemy uses his false prophet to raise up the image of the beast, using deceptive signs, even making fire fall from heaven, sparking a false revival (mimicking the Shabuot after Messiah's ascension) as people worship the beast and its image. Revelation 16:4 cautions that these signs are actually performed by demonic spirits. Those who have the Mark of the Beast and worship the image of the beast will be deceived.

When we see the establishment of this false system of worship, as prophecied, then we know that Messiah's coming and the final Exodus are very near.

The physical appearance of the antimessiah is an important sign to watch for, as he will set up a false global system of worship through which those not written in the Lamb's Book of Life will receive the Mark of the Beast.

However, we are assured in the Scriptures that Messiah Himself will appear to deliver His people and destroy the works of Satan forever.

Daniel 9:27 says that "the decreed destruction" will be poured out upon the one who causes the abomination of desolation, which is simply the antimessiah system of idolatrous worship.

This system ushers the world into an era of unprecedented lawlessness, which is why the head of the antimessiah system is called "the man of lawlessness." The Scriptures say that when the wicked rule, the people perish.

They invite the wrath of 𐤀𐤃𐤁𐤏 Who sends His Son to put an end to the wicked reign of Satan, rescue the remnant of YAH from the defiled earth, and usher in a reign of peace. The messengers of 𐤀𐤃𐤁𐤏 are sent with 7 bowls, each containing a plague to pour upon the wicked who remain upon the earth.

THE 7 LAST PLAGUES

- 1 Evil wicked sore
- 2 Sea becomes blood and all sea creatures die
- 3 Rivers and fountains also become blood
- 4 Sun scorches men with fire
- 5 Darkness falls on the seat of the beast and its kingdom
- 6 Euphrates River dries up
- 7 Great earthquake and massive hailstorm

Listen to the reading on the last plagues:



FOR AT THAT TIME THERE WILL BE GREAT TRIBULATION, UNMATCHED FROM THE BEGINNING OF THE WORLD UNTIL NOW, AND NEVER TO BE SEEN AGAIN.

MAT 24:21

The Great Tribulation comes after the appearance of the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION, according to Messiah's account in MattithYahu (Matthew) 24. He warns that this will be the most trying time in human history. He didn't say believers will be raptured before it, but He gives guidance on how we can endure it.

The main warning that He gives us for this period is: "For false messiahs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and wonders that would deceive even the elect, if that were possible." He admonishes us to not fall for fables about His appearance.

He then goes on to say: "Immediately after the tribulation of those days: 'The sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from the sky, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.' At that time the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and all the tribes of the earth will mourn. They will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great esteem. And He will send out His messengers with a loud trumpet call, and **they will gather His elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other** (Matthew 24:29-31)."

This is the final exodus from Satan's wicked system, and the chosen will live and reign with Messiah for a thousand years. This is the 7th Millennium. Meanwhile, Satan will be bound in chains and released after the thousand years, when the final showdown will take place. He and his followers will attempt to war against Messiah and his followers. Messiah will soon after send all the forces of evil, including Satan, into the lake of fire and brimstone, which is the second death. He will give a crown of life to His beloved!

BAR ABBA'S 2ND CHANCE

Imagine that you were behind bars, on death row, just waiting for that dreaded moment when your life would be snuffed out from you. Your execution is sealed—a certain end to your life's journey. But all of a sudden, something shifts! Something phenomenal happens. You receive the unexpected news that you've been pardoned and that you can go free—all because someone decided to die in your place—just to give you a second chance to get it right! This is the story of Bar Abba (also known as Barabbas), whose place was taken by Messiah YAHUSHUA, Sovereign of the Yahudim!

➤ HERE IS WHAT THE SCRIPTURE SAYS:

Now it was the governor's custom at the feast [Passover] to release to the crowd a prisoner of their choosing. At that time they were holding a notorious prisoner named Bar Abba.

So when the crowd had assembled, Pilate asked them, "Which one do you want me to release to you: Bar Abba, or YAHUSHUA who is called Messiah?" For he knew it was out of envy that they had handed YAHUSHUA over to him.

While Pilate was sitting on the judgment seat, his wife sent him this message: "Have nothing to do with that innocent man, for I have suffered terribly in a dream today because of Him."

But the chief priests and elders persuaded the crowds to ask for Bar Abba and to have YAHUSHUA put to death.

"Which of the two do you want me to release to you?" asked the governor. "Bar Abba," they replied.

"What then should I do with YAHUSHUA who is called Messiah?" Pilate asked. They all answered, "Impale Him!"

"Why?" asked Pilate. "What evil has He done?" But they shouted all the louder, "Impale Him!"

The above account is taken from *MattitYahu (Matthew) 27:15-23*. The books of *Mark (15:6-15)*, *Luke (23:18-25)*, *John (18:39-40)*, and *Acts (3:14)* also provide insights into what happened.



WHO WAS BAR ABBA?

FROM THE SCRIPTURES, WE KNOW

3 FACTS ABOUT BAR ABBA:



He was a part of a murderous insurrection in the City.



He had committed murder in the uprising.



He was imprisoned and "chained with his fellow rebels."

The Scriptures don't provide any more information about Bar Abba beyond the cited text we've included here. We don't know for certain whether Bar Abba seized the opportunity to change his life or whether he continued in his murderous ways. We only know that Messiah took his place, so he didn't have to die the second death.

Bar Abba, which appears to be a nickname and not his real name, means "son of the father" in Aramaic, a cousin language to Hebrew. The fundamental lesson in Messiah's death on the torture stake is that He took the place of all children of the Most High as a substitutionary sacrifice for our sins. Just as He took the place of Bar Abba and gave him a second chance to choose eternal life, so did Messiah take our place when He died, so we don't have to die the second death.

"He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By His stripes you are healed."

The Big Reveal: What Pilate wrote..:



THE ACCOUNT OF YAHUCHANAN (JOHN) 19:18-22 REVEALS SOMETHING THAT THE OTHER MESSIANIC WRITERS DID NOT:

There they impaled Him, and with Him two others, one on each side, with YAHUSHUA in the middle.

Pilate also had a notice posted on the stake. It read: YAHUSHUA of Natsareth, the King of the Yahudim [YAHUSHUA HaNatsari Umelech HaYahudim].

Many of the Yahudim read this sign, because the place where YAHUSHUA was impaled was near the city, and it was written in Hebrew, Latin, and Greek.

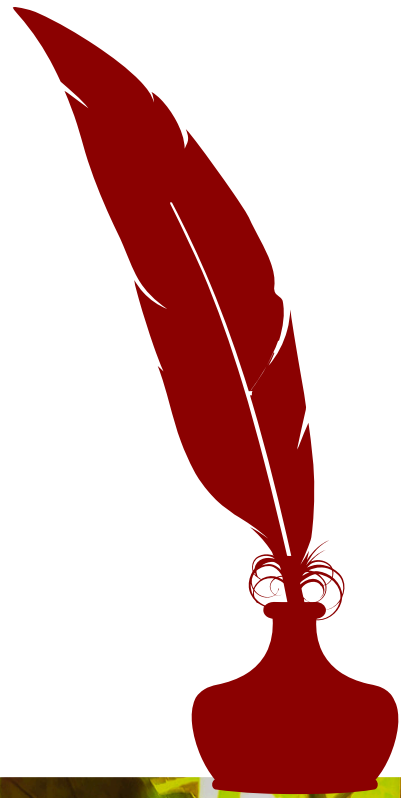

PARABLE OF THE 10 VIRGINS

“At that time the kingdom of heaven will be compared to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. Five of them were foolish, and five were wise. The foolish ones took their lamps but did not take along any **extra oil**. But **the wise ones took oil in flasks along with their lamps**. When the bridegroom was delayed, they all became drowsy and fell asleep. At midnight the cry rang out: **‘Here is the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!’** Then all the virgins woke up and trimmed their lamps. The foolish ones said to the wise, ‘Give us some of your oil; *our lamps are going out.*’ ‘No,’ said the wise ones, ‘or there may not be enough for both us and you. Instead, **go to those who sell oil and buy some for yourselves.**’ But while they were on their way to buy it, the bridegroom arrived. Those who were **ready** went in with him to the wedding banquet, and the door was shut. Later the other virgins arrived and said, ‘Master, master, open the door for us!’ But he replied, **‘Truly I tell you, I do not know you.’** Therefore **KEEP WATCH**, because you do not know the day or the hour (Mattithyahu (Matthew) 25:1-13).”



The Words no believer wants to hear:

There is much to unpack from the preceding text. However, the purpose of this article is simple: to get you to reflect upon where you stand right now! What is your spiritual condition today? What if Messiah were to come today, or what if you were to die today? Would you be counted worthy of being in the first resurrection or would you arise in the second? There are only two pathways in life; there is no in between. This is why it is so important for us to stay in the vine each and every day! We are the spiritual menorah (lampstand) and the lamps were always supplied with olive oil, to keep them burning. The High Priest was charged with keeping the lampstand in perfect condition, as it continued to give light in the temple. Our High Priest is our Messiah YAHUSHUA, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands. If we lack oil or run out of oil, it means that we need to seek His favor to fill us! The olive oil represents the Ruach or Spirit of YAH, by whom we are sealed for the day of redemption. If we fail to walk in the Spirit, we are disqualified from entering into the Kingdom of heaven. Messiah Himself will declare to us that He never knew us.

“Make every effort to enter through the narrow door. For many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able. After the master of the house gets up and shuts the door, you will stand outside knocking...” Luqas (Luke) 13:24-25

Let us Celebrate the Feast:

“THEREFORE, LET US KEEP THE FEAST, NOT WITH THE OLD BREAD, LEAVENED WITH MALICE AND WICKEDNESS, BUT WITH THE UNLEAVENED BREAD OF SINCERITY AND OF TRUTH.”

Qorintiyim Aleph (1 Corinthians) 5:8



The Law (Torah) has not been done away with; neither has Passover been changed to Easter. Here is the good news: the Torah as handed down by YAH to Moshe still remains intact. Remember the Words of our Messiah:

“For I tell you truly, until heaven and earth pass away, not a single jot, not a stroke of a pen, will disappear from the Torah until everything is accomplished.”

Mattithyahu (Matthew) 5:18

So there are two key questions we need to ask:

- (1) Have heaven and earth passed away?
- (2) Has everything been accomplished?

The answer to both of these questions is a resounding NO! So, it is established that the Law still remains in effect and intact! Yes, the enemy of our souls has tried so hard to blind our eyes and keep us in spiritual bondage. Remember how stubborn Pharoah was when he refused to let the children of YAH go, to attend the feast and to serve Him? The enemy's tactics have not changed; in fact, he has gotten better and better at keeping people tangled in a web of deceit.

But there is good news for you today: Messiah YAHUSHUA has come to set you free! *And who the Son sets free is free indeed!* (Yahuchanan - John 8:36)

THE PASSOVER ORDINANCES

“And this day will be a memorial for you, and you are to celebrate it as a feast to YAHUAH, as a permanent statute for the generations to come. For seven days you must eat unleavened bread. On the first day you are to remove the leaven from your houses. Whoever eats anything leavened from the first day through the seventh must be cut off from Israel. On the first day you are to hold a sacred assembly, and another on the seventh day. You must not do any work on those days, except to prepare the meals—that is all you may do. So you are to keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread, for on this very day I brought your divisions out of the land of Egypt. You must keep this day as a permanent statute for the generations to come. In the first month you are to eat unleavened bread, from the evening of the fourteenth day until the evening of the twenty-first day. For seven days there must be no leaven found in your houses. If anyone eats something leavened, that person, whether a foreigner or native of the land, must be cut off from the congregation of Israel. You are not to eat anything leavened; eat unleavened bread in all your homes.”



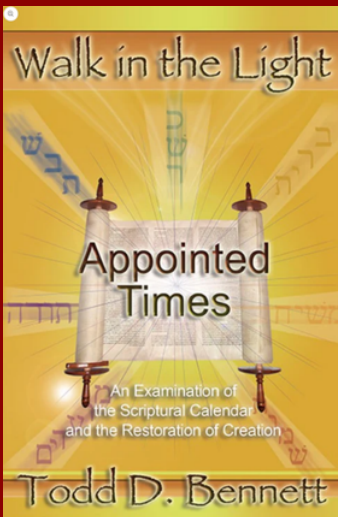

How we appear before YAHUAH at the feasts matters! In searching for photos to accompany this article, I found a plethora of images of people all dressed up for the event! Most women were wearing heavy makeup and bold jewelry. One important question we need to ask ourselves is whether we are dressing for YAH or dressing for ourselves. Let's go back into time to when Ya'acob took his entire family up to Beth'Al (the House of Al), where He had encountered YAHUAH in a vision (Gen 28) in which He saw a ladder with messengers traversing between heaven and earth and YAHUAH standing at the very top! He declared that this place had to be YAH's House.

Later in Gen 35, he and his family make a pilgrimage to this same place where he had encountered The Most High YAH.

Then Alahym said to Ya'acob, "Arise, go up to Beth'Al, and settle there. Build an altar there to the Alahym who appeared to you when you fled from your brother Esau." So Ya'acob told his household and all who were with him, "Get rid of the foreign idols that are among you. Purify yourselves and change your garments. Then let us arise and go to Beth'Al..." So they gave Ya'acob all their foreign idols and all their earrings, and Ya'acob buried them under the oak near Shechem.

(Genesis 35:1-4)

It becomes patently clear that in coming before YAHUAH, we all need to purify ourselves by removing the idols and immodesty from our life. In the Messianic Scriptures, there are many passages that reinforce this principle of purification, both inwardly and outwardly.

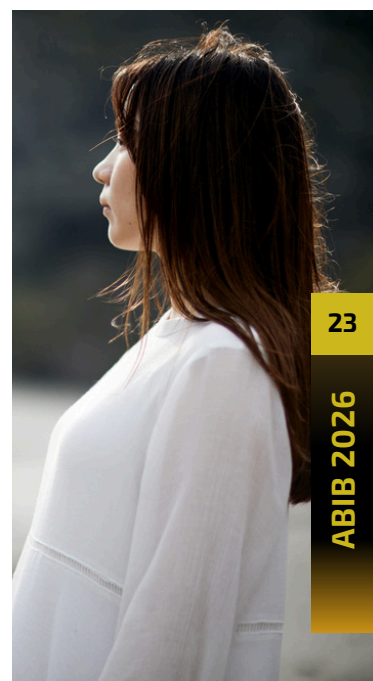
YAHUAH hates haughtiness! “YAHUAH also says: ‘Because the daughters of Tsiyon are haughty— walking with heads held high and wanton eyes, prancing and skipping as they go, jingling the bracelets on their ankles— YAHUAH will bring sores on the heads of the daughters of Tsiyon, and YAHUAH will make their foreheads bare.’” (YashaYahu (Isaiah) 3:16-17 BSB)

Proverbs 16:18 says, “Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall.”

“Your beauty should not come from outward adornment, such as braided hair or gold jewelry or fine clothes, but from the inner disposition of your heart, the unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is precious in Alahym’s sight. For this is how the set-apart women of the past adorned themselves. They put their hope in Alahym and were submissive to their husbands,” says Kěpha Aleph (1 Peter) 3:3-5.

“Likewise, I want the women to adorn themselves with respectable apparel, with modesty, and with self-control, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or expensive clothes, but with good deeds, as is proper for women who profess to worship Alahym,” says Timotiyos Aleph (1 Timothy) 2:9-10.

The conclusion of the entire matter is this: “Fear Alahym and keep His commandments, because this is the whole duty of man (Ecc 12:13).”





DRESSING THE PART

“THIS IS HOW YOU ARE TO EAT [THE PASSOVER]: YOUR LOINS MUST BE GIRDED, WITH YOUR SANDALS ON YOUR FEET AND YOUR STAFF IN YOUR HAND. YOU ARE TO EAT IN HASTE; IT IS THE PĔSAḤ OF יהוה.”

SHEMOTH (EXODUS) 12:11

In searching for styles of garments to wear for Passover, I received the reminder from the Father that our concern should be for our spiritual attire more than the outward appearance; for although people may watch your outward appearance to judge you, YAH looks at the heart. He then reminded me of Messiah’s Words: “And why do you worry about clothes? Consider how the lilies of the field grow: They do not labor or spin. Yet I tell you that not even Shelomoh in all his esteem was adorned like one of these. If that is how Alahym clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, will He not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? Therefore do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ (Matthew 6:28-31) The set-apart ones are dressed in fine linen, which is a figurative garment symbolizing the righteousness of Messiah. This is all that matters to YAH!



On this Passover, put on Messiah!

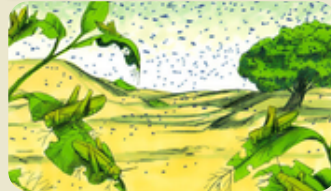

EASY UNLEAVENED BREAD



INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups flour
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup water
- 1 tsp salt
- 4 tbps olive oil

MAKES 8

RESOURCES

- rolling pin
- kneading bowl
- knife or dough cutter
- pan for cooking



DIRECTIONS

1. Add flour to a mixing bowl.
2. Add salt and mix well.
3. Pour in the olive oil and mix into the dry ingredients.
4. Finally, gradually add the water, kneading it into the dough.
5. Turn out the dough on a flat surface. Knead for a few minutes and then place back in the bowl.
6. Divide the dough into the desired serving size.
7. Knead with a rolling pin or by hand to flatten the dough.
8. Finally, cook on a preheated surface (either a pan or flat baking surface), flipping the bread after the first side is adequately cooked.

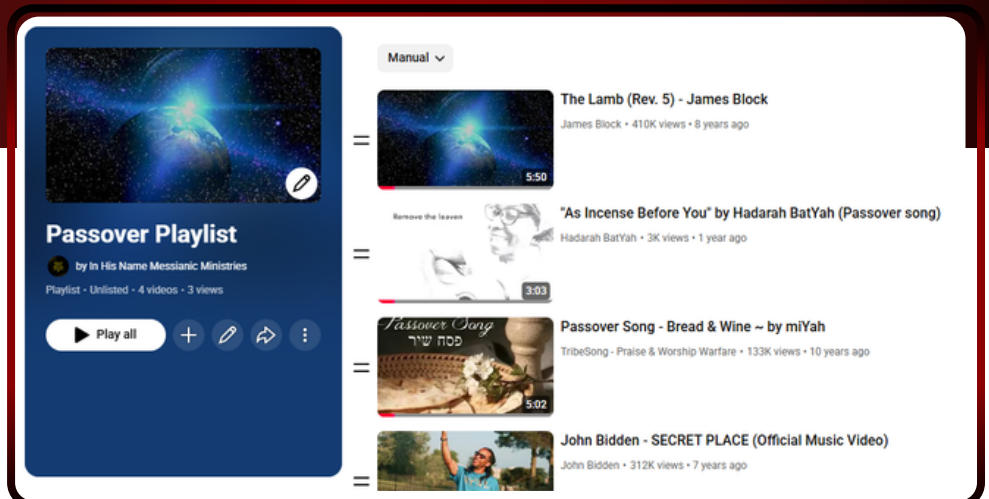

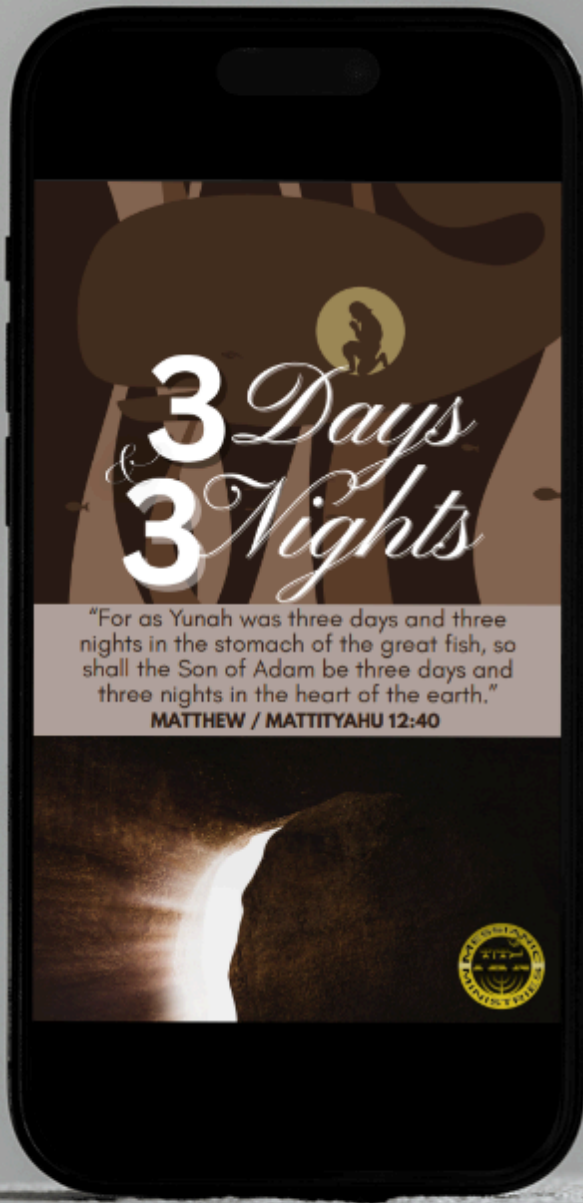

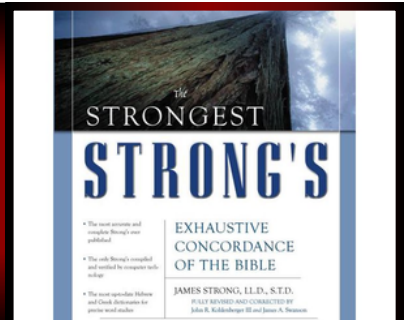
